

Students who participate in internships and co-ops...

- Complete college at higher rates than those who do not, are better prepared for the workplace and are better paid
- Learn more about themselves and their future career interests
- Gain a better understanding of a specific company/industry and the possibility of a longer term career fit
- Approximately 63% of students with paid internships converted to full-time upon graduation (NACE, 2013)

A series of career development modules and other resources that can assist students to manage their careers from identifying and exploring interests and different academic options to getting prepared for their job search and first job.







Selected 2012-2013 Statistics

- 3900+ unique employers posted approved positions
- 8300+ approved career employment postings
- 4200+ approved experiential learning positions
- 23,000+ eligible users logged into the system at least once
- 1,300+ users in OnPACE (56% first and second year students)

Best Practices for Utilizing Buckeye Careers with First-year Students
