



WHAT HAS BEEN SURPRISING FOR THE

BETTER? Overall positive Helpful faculty/ staff campus community members (peers) 16.53% 22.59% Amount of Number of activities, Campus Supportive events, and feels small opportunities Resources to get involved 10.19% 13.22% 9.37%

### Other responses included the themes of:

Increased academic rigor (and being successful)

The large campus

Small class sizes despite such a large student population Overall ease of transition, and the diversity of the campus

# WHAT HAS BEEN DISAPPOINTING IN THEIR FIRST SEMESTER?

Course difficulties (frustration with instructors, rigor, results): 17.45%

Lack of community/ friends: 10.53%

Impersonal Interactions (instructors and advisors): 7.2%

Hard to connect with involvement opportunities (lack of communication, not enough time, finding appropriate programs, football tickets): 5.54%

Impact of being a non-traditional student (age, parents, military experience, coming from work force) on being engaged in the student life: 3.88%

Other responses included the themes of:

Campus dining and food

Survey course

Feeling treated like a freshman

Lack of communication about program deadlines

Transfer credit

Campus safety

# WHAT DO TRANSFERS KNOW THAT THEY WISH THEY WOULD HAVE KNOWN PRIOR TO ENROLLING?

Academic Expectations (time management skills, balancing a more rigorous course load, study skills) 13.24%

Majors (how to apply for direct admittance, degree track, requirements prior to transferring, GE requirements, transfer credit evaluation sooner) 12.39%

**Scheduling and Course Selection 8.45%** 

To take advantage of campus resources for success (tutoring) 3.99%

*Understanding financial aid* (internal and external)


The limitations to student experience as a non-traditional student

Knowledge of the honors program


To get involved early
